Grafton Showgrounds - Visit the Art Show in The Barn & the Lapidary Display in the Gem Club rooms

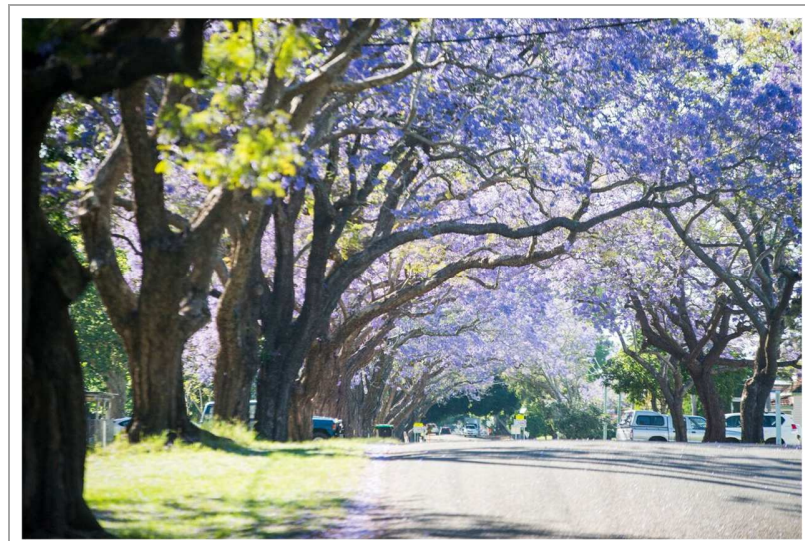
